## Conference Programme

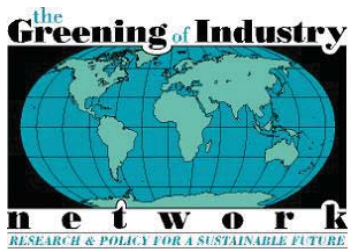
